



## MAKING A REFERRAL TO THOME PACE

### What is PACE®? (Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly)

PACE® is a program for people over the age of 55 living with disabilities. A trained and experienced interdisciplinary team of healthcare professionals will provide coordinated care that helps these individuals live safely in their homes and communities. PACE® provides all the care services covered by Medicare and Medicaid, as authorized by the interdisciplinary team, as well as additional medically-necessary care and services not covered by Medicare and Medicaid. ### Who can join a PACE® program?

Refer people to join Thome PACE if they are:

- 55 years or older
- Live in Jackson, Hillsdale or Lenawee County
- Able to be certified by the State of Michigan as meeting the need for nursing home level of care
- Able to live safely in the community with the support of PACE® services

### Making a referral to Thome PACE®

#### Preferred Referral Methods:

1. Obtain permission from the person(s) being referred to provide relevant information to the PACE® Community Relations Team.
2. Call, email or fax the referral information to the PACE Community Relations Team. (A brief list of key referral data and contact information for the team is on the next page.)

#### Additional Referral Methods:

1. Provide PACE® brochure, website and/or other PACE® literature, along with Community Relations Team member business card to the person(s) being referred.

## Key Information to include when referring to Thome PACE

### Referral:

- Full Name
- Address
- Phone Number
- Date of Birth or Age
- County of Residence
- Insurance Information
- DPOA/Caregiver Information

### Referring Contact:

- Full name
- Phone Number
- Email Address
- Relationship to the Referred Individual
- Referral has Agreed to be Contacted by Thome PACE
- Any Additional Notes

Information can be provided in any form, including face sheets or medical records, and may be submitted by fax, email or phone.

If the individual schedules an assessment with Thome PACE, a staff member may contact you with a signed release of information from the individual to release more complete health care records.
